## **PROJECT SUMMARY**

Following up from a 2020 Regional Planning and Knowledge Sharing Workshop, in 2021 Polar Knowledge Canada launched a collaborative assessment process to produce five technical papers answering important questions identified by northern stakeholders. Each technical paper focused on one of five key themes, with the objective of synthesizing current research findings across numerous research programs in plain language.

Fuse Consulting was engaged to work closely with each technical working group to develop infographics that could support each technical paper and bring core concepts to life. Fuse participated in working group meetings, helping each working group identify and refine core messaging for the infographics and adapting as each technical paper took shape. The infographics center northern communities and Indigenous ways of life, connecting technical aspects of each theme to important values like food security. Along with their integration into the technical papers/summary report, the infographics were made available online in English, French, Inuktitut, and Inuinnaqtun.
